FINAL INSTRUCTIONS 1

Thank you for your entry, which has been accepted as follows:

Scrutiny will take place in the car park of the Premier Inn, Lisburn from 07:30.
Documentation will take place in the meeting room beside reception from 07:30.
Breakfast will be provided from approx 08:00 – 09:30 in the hotel restaurant.

Amendments and additions to Supplementary Regulations:

- The first control of the event, TC01, will be at the exit of the hotel car park. Car zero due time at TC01 is 09:30. Therefore, car 1 will be due at 09:31, car 2 will be due at 09:32 ... car 15 will be due at 09:45, etc.
- Running order will be as per the Entry List which is included in your pack.
- MSA Blue Book REF R 18.6.5 applies – *“Where an event includes any section or special test held wholly or in part on private property all vehicles must carry a Small Spill Kit complying with J 5.20.13”*

At Scrutiny the following will be **required**:

- A warning triangle
- A SMALL Spill Kit

At Documentation the following will be **required** – please have correct money:

- £18.00 to cover Lockton Road Section Insurance.
- £10.00 UAC club membership per crew member if not already paid.

Only fully paid entries will be allowed to start the event.

The measured mile is marked with UAC boards (location map available at sign on).

All tests are Special Tests. Therefore both competitors are required to remain in the car for each test and **MUST NOT** walk the tests beforehand.

At Brian's test take care at the caution board which marks a drain channel.

Time cards should be handed in at Passage Controls which have been marked in the road book and shown on route maps supplied.

For anyone wanting to use their own maps, OS sheet 20 D Edition covers the route.

PSNI have been informed of route and Special Test locations. Road sections have been timed to allow sufficient time to travel between tests.
